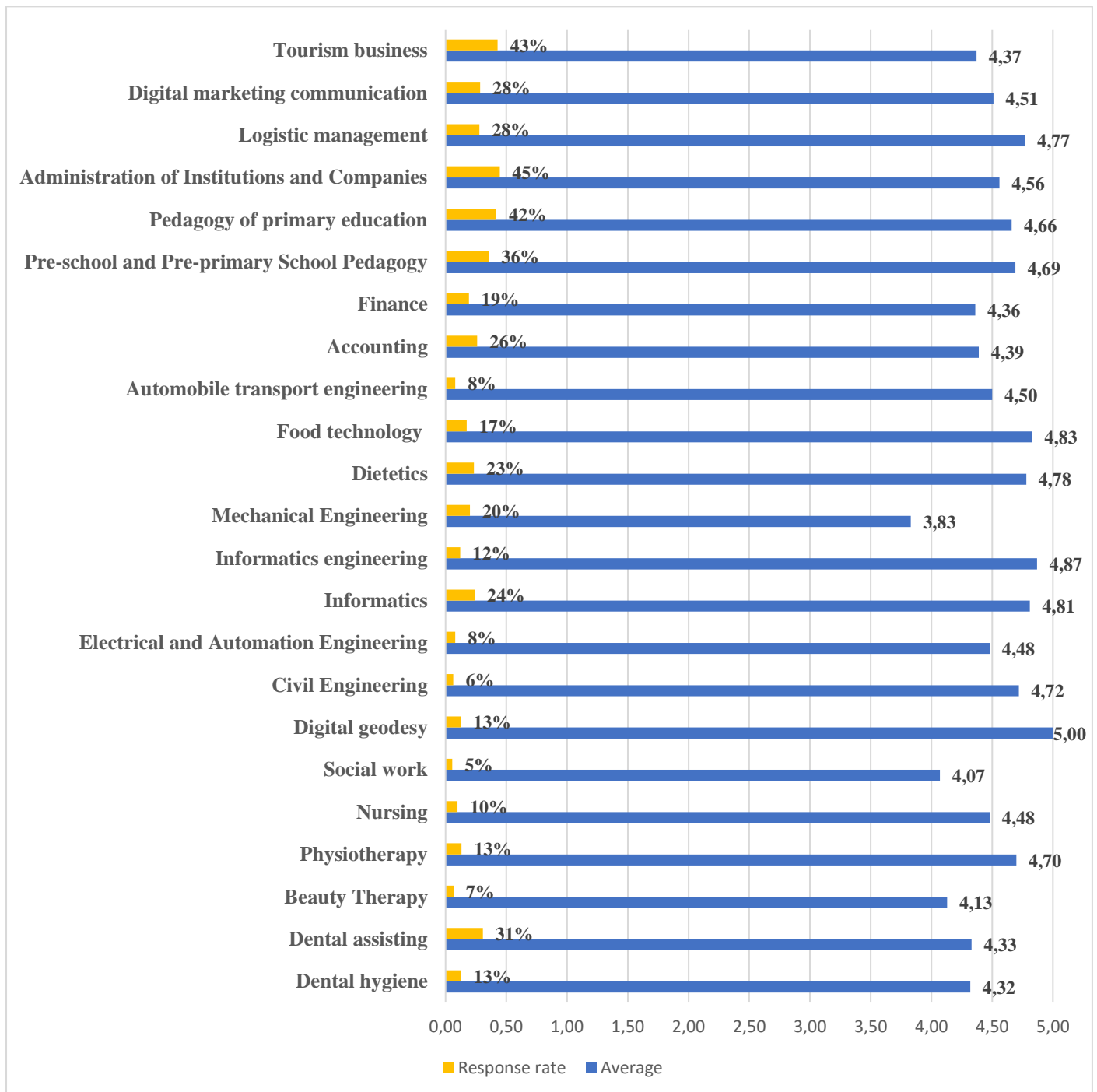
**STUDENTS OPINION ABOUT THE STUDY OF THE SUBJECT –**

**SPRING SEMESTRE 2021-2022**

At the Klaipėda State university of applied sciences, a subject-level survey of students' opinions was conducted in the information system "Edina" in May-June 2022. During the survey, students had the opportunity to express their opinion about each subject studied during the semester.

The purpose of the survey is to assess students' opinion about the quality of studies at the University.

Average of survey response rate - 21%, the number of filled and submitted questionnaires - 1528 out of 6498.



The chart above shows the student opinion rate averages (on a 5-point scale) in each programme. The percentage line shows how many questionnaires were filled out of all activated questionnaires in programme.

The maximum average - 5 points students rated for the digital geodesy programme, but the response rate of this programme is only 13%.

The Informatics engineering programme was also highly rated - 4.87 points. The maximum rating average of 5 points was given by the students of computer science engineering to the following subjects: Web technologies, Probability theory and mathematical statistics, Computer Architecture and Operating Systems, Methodology of Applied Research, Robotics, Numerical methods in engineering.

Student opinion about Food technology programme rated - 4.83 points. Subjects evaluated with a maximum average of 5 points: Food chemistry and analysis, Organic Chemistry and Basics of Biochemistry, Laboratory Testing of Food 2, Management of Food Quality and Safety, Food law.

Informatics students also rated the subjects of the programme with high scores, so the average score is 4.81. Subjects evaluated with the maximum score: Web technologies, Probability theory and mathematical statistics, Programming in Java, Basics of management, Augmented reality, Computer graphics, Information security, Psychology, Numerical methods.

The highest percentage of student response rate is in the programme of administration of institutions and companies - 45%, the average rating is 4.56 points. Students studying in this programme give positive feedback on the competences of the teachers, well-chosen teaching methods, clarity of tasks.

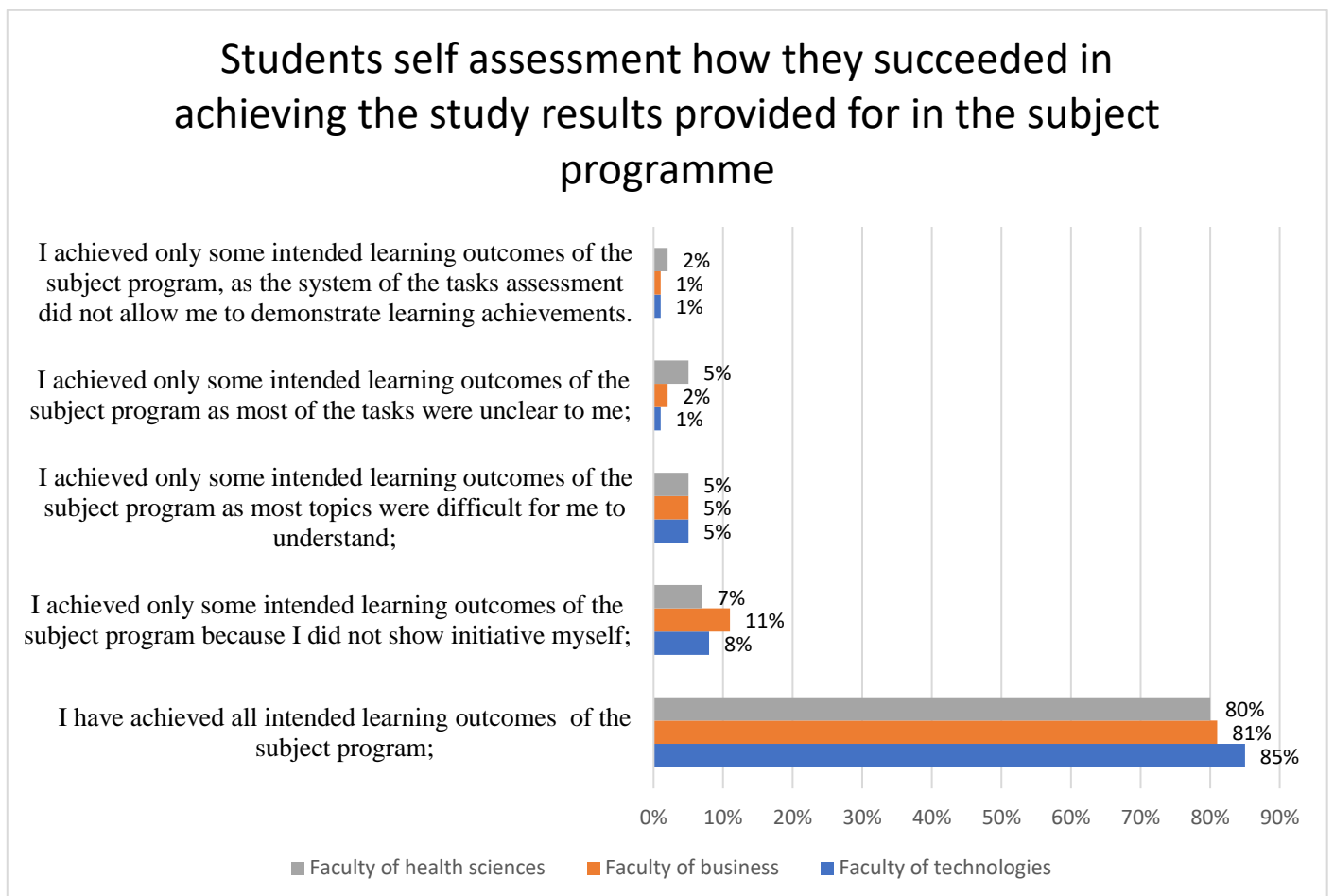
There is also a high response rate of tourism business students - 43%, and the average rating in the programme - 4.37. Tourism business students were happy with the teachers' help, good atmosphere during the lectures.

Pedagogy of primary education was evaluated with 4.66 points, and the percentage of response rate was 42%. The students of this programme emphasized the knowledge gained during practice, enjoyed discussions during lectures and the opportunity to freely express their opinions.

The overall average rating of the students' opinion of all University programmes is 4.53 points out of 5.

In the survey, students had to assess themselves while studying the subject:

- achieved all intended learning outcomes of the subject programme;
- only some intended learning outcomes of the subject programme because student did not show initiative myself;
- achieved only some intended learning outcomes of the subject programme as most topics were difficult for student to understand;
- achieved only some intended learning outcomes of the subject programme as most of the tasks were unclear to the student;
- achieved only some intended learning outcomes of the subject programme, as the system of the tasks assessment did not allow to demonstrate learning achievements.



From the data presented, it can be seen that 85% of students of the Faculty of Technology, 81% of students of the Faculty of Business and 80% of students of the Faculty of Health Sciences achieved all study results. That's an average of 82% of University students achieving all expected learning outcomes.

Students also indicated that they achieved only some intended learning outcomes because they did not show initiative themselves, on average 9% of University students. The lowest percentage of students stated that they did not achieve all the expected learning outcomes, because the task assessment did not allow to demonstrate the learning achievements.

Summarizing the result of the survey can be said that the subjects in the programmes are rated high, the percentage of response rate remains stable, compared to previously conducted surveys. All collected and systematized data are transferred to responsible persons in order to improve the quality of studying.
