

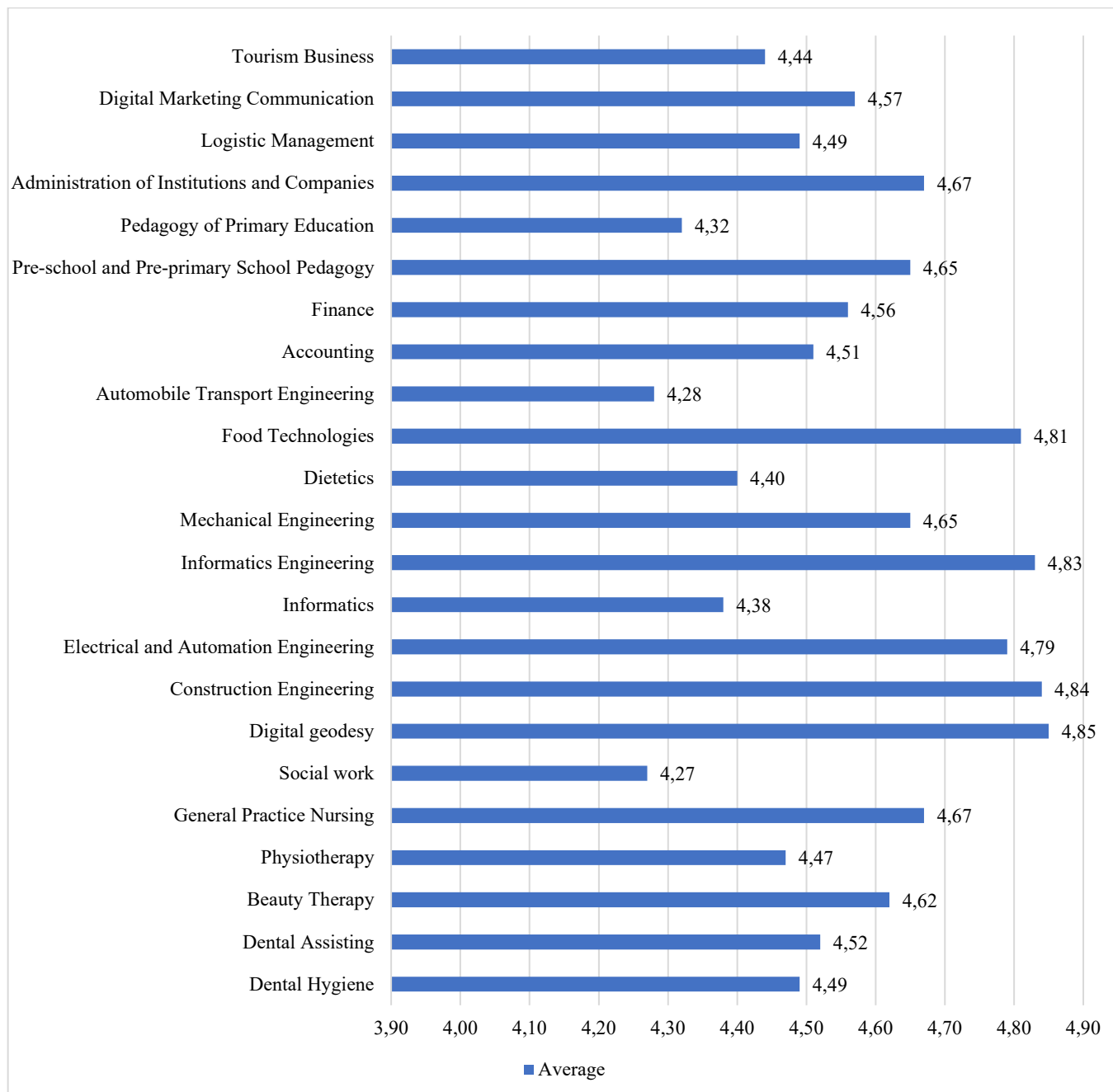


**HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION  
KLAIPĖDOS VALSTYBINĖ KOLEGIJA  
STUDENTS OPINION ABOUT THE STUDY OF THE SUBJECT  
AUTUMN SEMESTRE 2022-2023**



At the Higher Education Institution Klaipėdos Valstybinė Kolegija, a subject-level survey of students' opinions was conducted in the information system "Edina" in January 2023. During the survey, students had the opportunity to express their opinion about each subject studied during the semester. The purpose of the survey is to assess students' opinion about the quality of studies at the Higher Education Institution.

The students expressed their opinion about each studied subject by filling out a separate questionnaire for each subject. After summarizing the obtained data, the statistical average of the responses in each Programme is presented.

From the presented diagram, it can be seen that the highest score is the Digital Geodesy (4.85), Civil Engineering (4.84), and Informatics Engineering (4.83) Programmes. As many as

60% of the subjects of the Digital Geodesy Programme were rated by students with the highest score. Respondents indicate that they liked the most: "interesting topics, practical work, they don't teach dry theory, a lot of real-life examples are used during lectures".

Construction Engineering students emphasized that they mostly liked laboratory work while studying.

All the students of the Informatics Engineering Programme who took part in the survey stated that during their studies, the prescribed lecture schedule was followed (lectures started and ended on time), and the things they liked most while studying were: "Availability of teachers, practical tasks". All three top rated Programmes are in the Faculty of Technology.

At the Faculty of Business, students rated the Administration of Institutions and Companies Programme the best - 4.67 points. In this Programme, students had the maximum score in the evaluation of: Psychology of communication, Positive thinking, Accounting and finance, Media communication, Organization of business events subjects.

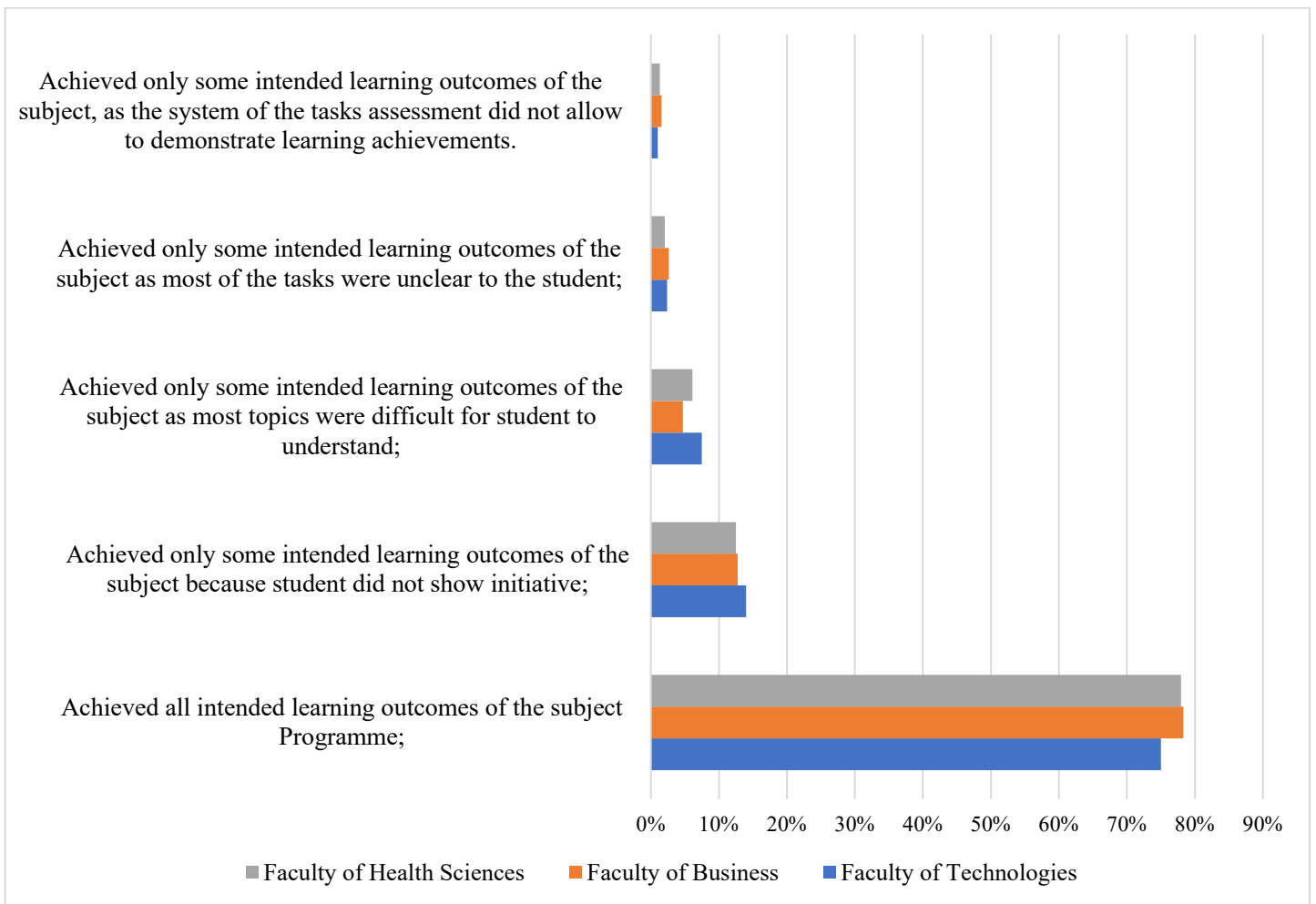
The students liked most when studying: "non-standard teaching methods, clear assessment criteria, topics explained in detail, various practical tasks, invited guests participating in lectures."

In the Faculty of Health Sciences, General Practice Nursing Programme was rated the highest. The students of this program emphasized and gave very positive feedback about the teachers and the educational methods they chose: "The teacher is amazing, the material is presented in a way that the student can understand without any objections; The teacher's fairness, honesty, discipline, quality of lectures, interesting lectures, lots of examples, lectures were easy to learn and understand, very interesting to listen to".

The overall average of the student opinion rating for all Programmes is 4.57 points out of 5.

In the survey, students had to assess themselves while studying the subject:

- achieved all intended learning outcomes of the subject;
- achieved only some intended learning outcomes of the subject because student did not show initiative;
- achieved only some intended learning outcomes of the subject as most topics were difficult for student to understand;
- achieved only some intended learning outcomes of the subject as most of the tasks were unclear to the student;
- achieved only some intended learning outcomes of the subject, as the system of the tasks assessment did not allow to demonstrate learning achievements.



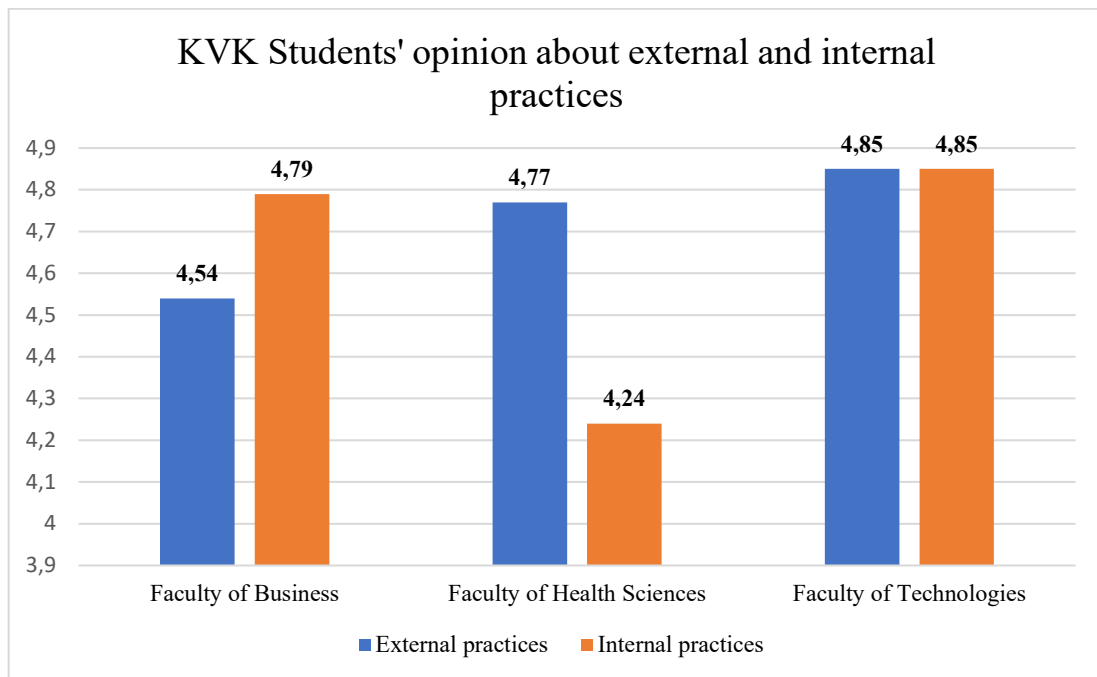
From the data presented can be seen that 75% of students of the Faculty of Technology, 78% of students of the Faculty of Business and 78% of students of the Faculty of Health Sciences achieved all study results. On average 77% of KVK Higher Education Institution students achieve all expected results. On average 13.3% of students stated that they achieved only some study results because they did not show initiative themselves.

Summarizing the collected data, it can be said that all KVK subjects, according to the students, were evaluated with averages higher than 4 points (out of 5 possible). All collected and systematized data are transferred to responsible persons in order to improve the quality of studying.

# STUDENTS' OPINION ABOUT THE ORGANIZATION AND PERFORMANCE OF PRACTICES

## 2022 - 2023 M.M. AUTUMN SEMESTER

In order to assess student satisfaction throughout the study process, students had the opportunity to fill out a questionnaire about the organization of internships and their performance. Separate questionnaires were addressed to KVK's internal and external practices. The summarized data is presented in the table:



Students rated internships the best at the Faculty of Technology, the average for both internal and external internships was 4.85 points out of 5.

In the Faculty of Health Sciences, students rated external practices better than internal ones. The students of this faculty liked the most during the external practices: "acquired knowledge; a very good practical course manager, sincere, helpful, always giving advice; Put theoretical knowledge into practice."

In the Faculty of Business, students rated internal practices with a higher score of 4.79. The students liked the most during internal practice: "Methodological material with explanations was provided; Teachers' communication and understanding, concrete explanations and examples; how all the work, discussions and mutual cooperation went; you could feel comfortable and you didn't have to worry about anything;"

The expressed opinion contributes to the improvement of the quality of the studied subjects, helps to identify problems arising in the study process and possible ways of solving them.
