

"ERASMUS" STUDENTS OPINION ABOUT THE STUDY OF THE SUBJECT – SPRING SEMESTRE 2021-2022

The survey was conducted in May - June, 2021 - 2022 academic year. The aim of the research is to evaluate students' opinion about the study of the subject.

Completed questionnaires by faculties: Faculty of Technology - 71 questionnaires, Faculty of Business - 27, Faculty of Health Sciences - 17.

A total of 115 out of 270 questionnaires were filled in. The response rate was 43%.


Answers were received from 17 study programs. A total of 65 studied subjects were evaluated.

Students rated their attendance at 93%.

The overall average of research estimates for all subjects studied is 4.46 points out of 5.

The graph below shows the average grades of "Erasmus" students in each program.





The highest average is 4.97 points in the Informatics program. The students of this program stated: "I liked this subject because it was practice oriented", "This topic was research oriented and allows me to do a lot of research".

Food technology students also rated the program highly - 4.94 points out of 5. In the survey, they indicated that they liked: "Link between reality and subject. Interesting topics", "Laboratory work".

The students of the Beauty therapy program evaluated themselves with the lowest score - 3.29, the students' suggestion for improving the studied subjects is to improve the English language skills of the teachers. When expressing their opinion, the students of this program positively evaluated the opportunities for self-expression.

The expressed opinion contributes the improvement of the quality of the studied subjects, helps to identify problems arising in the study process and possible ways of solving them.
